DAYSIDE VINYL WINDOWS (product) are warranted by Dayside Industries Ltd (Dayside) against defects in material and workmanship for life* subject to the terms and conditions set out herein.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

1. VINYL FRAMES AND SASHES against warping, peeling, flaking, blistering and rotting.
2. HARDWARE COMPONENTS against failure or breakage not resulting from misuse.
3. SEALED GLASS UNITS against factory seal failure.

THIS LIFETIME * WARRANTY shall be understood to mean, and apply to the lifetime of the original purchaser of Product or subsequent owner, subject to the terms and conditions of transfer of ownership set out herein; or a period of forty (40) years from the original date of purchase of Product, whichever occurs first.

In the event of corporate, investment, third party, or any ownership wherein the subject property is not the principle residence of the owner or purchaser, the terms of this warranty shall apply for a limited period of twenty (20) years, subject to any limitations herein and shall not be transferable.

THIS WARRANTY IS TRANSFERABLE to the subsequent owner of the Property provided Dayside receives written notice of same along with a standard transfer fee, within thirty (30) days of the transfer of the Property. Failure to so notify Dayside or to make payment of the transfer fee shall result in the termination of any obligations on the part of Dayside.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

The terms set out in this warranty become effective upon receipt by Dayside of the registration card completed by the Dealer, signed by the original purchaser of Product, and delivered to Dayside within thirty (30) days of purchase. Registration may also be completed on-line at www.dayside.ca. Failure to submit or fully complete a warranty registration card or register on line may result in the loss of warranty coverage and remedies under the terms set out herein.

CLEANING OF YOUR NEW WINDOWS/DOORS

Ideally the windows and doors in your home are thoroughly cleaned at least once a year, if not twice a year.

It's an excellent idea to clean the windows and doors at the end of the fall and spring season. As well as scheduling the window cleaning for the end of the fall or spring also schedule for a day without much sun. Too much sun tends to dry the windows too quickly, leading to unsightly streaks.

To clean your window properly will need to gather a few essential supplies.

Use a dusting brush attachment and vacuum the interior of the window sills and frames.

Use a cleaning sponge or soft cloth to dip into the cleaning solution, squeezing the excess liquid.

Wash the windows with circular movements: wash from the corners and outer perimeter of the window towards the interior or centre of the window.

Dry the window using a squeegee, paper towel, lint free cloth or newspaper. All the strokes you make should go in the same direction: if you apply vertical strokes on one side and horizontal on the other you will be able to see.

If you are using crumpled newspaper to dry, wear gloves to avoid ink on your hands, the ink will not transfer to the glass.

Wash the exterior of the windows following the above steps with the exception of the vacuuming.

Alternative Cleaning Solutions

Vinegar: make a solution of ½ teaspoon of liquid soap, ¼ cup vinegar (white) and 2 cups water; mix in a spray bottle. This combination will be streak free and will take off the residue left by other cleaners. Spray on and wipe off with a lint free cloth or squeegee.

Ammonia: the main ingredient used in most commercial window cleaners and it can be more effective than vinegar. For ammonia based solution use 1 tablespoon for every gallon of water. Mix solution in a spray bottle and wipe with sponge or soft cloth.

Lemon: with this solution will have a scrubber and a cleaner all in one. Squeeze a lemon and remove all seeds. Then press the skin directly to the window and rub circles around smudges. Work in small areas and follow with a cloth to dry.

MAINTAINING YOUR INVESTMENT

Lubricating the operating components for windows and doors

We recommend using a silicone spray on the operating components of your windows and doors. On casement windows this would include the operating arms, handles, rubber seals and screws. This will prevent from rusting, ice build-up or tearing of the rubber seals.

On sliders we recommend that all tracks be free of dirt and grit. Awning windows should be treated the same as casement windows ensuring all operating components are lubricated.

Check the interior and exterior caulking looking for any cracks or missing caulking. We recommend applying a new bead of caulking to ensure freedom from draft, insect invasion, water leakage etc. Caulking is not covered under warranty.

Lubricating the operating components for doors

Lubricate all operational components with silicone spray; Handles, hinges, lock cylinders, rubber seals on the bottom of door and around the door.

Why maintain?

The silicone spray provides a protective coating that aids for easier operation. This application prevents the rubber seals from sticking to the sill or frame and tearing upon opening.

Exterior and interior caulking is exposed to elements that will over time breakdown the viscosity of the product. These recommendations are the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure the performance of your investment.

Good maintenance practice will ensure a long life for the product and provide the comfort and energy savings you insist upon.

MOISTURE ASSESSMENT CHECKLIST

Excess condensation on windows is an indication that the relative humidity in a home is too high. The following are the most common causes of high relative humidity.

- Bathroom or kitchen fans not vented to the outdoors
- Exposed soil, plants or gravel crawlspace
- Damp foundation or basement
- Furnace humidifier set too high
- Heat recovery ventilator (HRV) ventilation rate too low
- Electric heating without (HRV) or other ventilation system
- Clothes dryer not ducted to the outside
- Drying clothes indoors on open racks
- Whirlpool, greenhouse or large aquarium
- Abundance of plants
- Firewood drying indoors
- Bathroom usage (showers & other running water)
- Kitchen usage (washing dishes, dish washer & cooking)
